

## 2010-2011 HFCS ELEMENTARY DRESS CODE

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**The purpose of the dress code in the Holy Family Catholic School system is to aid in providing a focused learning environment and to minimize faddishness and comparison among students. The dress code must be consistently appropriate for that environment to foster Christian respect and modesty. Parents are expected to help the school staff enforce the dress code policy. The school administration will have final discretion on what is appropriate or not appropriate for school wear.**

### Shirts

- Solid colors of NAVY BLUE, WHITE, or RED
- Short or long-sleeved polo shirts or dress shirts with fold-down collars
- Must be free of lettering (except for HFCS system or HFCS school names)
- Must be free of contrasting embroidery and trim (except for small manufacturer logos)
- Must be worn as designed and buttoned appropriately
- Must be long enough to be tucked in for liturgies and other special events
- Turtlenecks are allowed
- Only solid white short-sleeved t-shirts may be worn under uniform shirts and these undershirts must be tucked in at all times

### Sweaters/Sweatshirts

- Solid colors of NAVY BLUE, WHITE, RED, or GRAY
- HFCS system or HFCS school garments with color combinations of blue/gold/white are acceptable
- Must be free of lettering (except for HFCS system or HFCS school names)
- Must be free of contrasting embroidery and trim (except for small manufacturer logos)
- None of these garments may have a hood
- A dress code shirt must be worn under sweaters and sweatshirts
- No zippered sweaters or sweatshirts
- Long-sleeved crew neck or cardigan sweaters allowed
- Fleece wear is not allowed

### Pants

- Solid colors of NAVY BLUE, KHAKI (tan), BROWN, or BLACK dress pants
- Must be free of contrasting stitch or trim
- Denim, spandex, leggings, sweatpants, and wind pants are not allowed

### Shorts/Capris

- Solid colors of NAVY BLUE, KHAKI (tan), BROWN, or BLACK
- Dress shorts and capri pants may be worn from the beginning of the year through October 15 and from April 15 through the end of the year
- Shorts must be no shorter than 3½ inches from the top of the kneecap

### Skirts/Skort/Jumpers (Girls only)

- Solid colors of NAVY BLUE, KHAKI (tan), BROWN, BLACK, or HFCS plaid uniform skirt, jumper, or skort
- Shorts may be worn under skirts/jumpers
- Skirts/shorts/jumpers must be no shorter than 3½ inches from the top of the kneecap

### Shoes/Socks/Tights

- Closed-toed and closed-heeled tennis shoes or dress shoes (no heelys, crocs, moccasins or boots)
- Socks or tights required at all times
- Socks and tights must be solid NAVY BLUE, WHITE, RED, or BLACK

### Accessories/Hairstyles

- Simple post earrings only – no hoop earrings
- Hats/caps are not permitted
- Fingernail polish is allowed
- Display of body piercing other than ears is not allowed
- Hair must be a non-distracting color and style
- No makeup allowed and no tattoos

### Dress Down Days

- No clothing that has drug, alcohol, tobacco, or sexual references
- No bare midriffs, spaghetti straps or halter-tops
- Shorts, dresses, or skirts must be no shorter than 3½ inches from the top of the kneecap
- Regular dress code shoe regulations always apply, including out-of-uniform days
- Out-of-Uniform days will not be scheduled for all-school Mass days

### Scout Uniforms

- Allowed on meeting day

***Note: The dress code is reviewed and revised annually by the Holy Family Catholic Schools Student Services Committee. This committee meets monthly throughout the school year.
