

Defensive Driving Training – Volunteer Driver

We appreciate our volunteers that drive for school activities. The safety of our students is of the utmost importance! As a requirement from Catholic Mutual, the Archdiocesan insurance center, all volunteers driving for school activities (field trips, driving school vehicles, taking personal vehicles to meetings, running Holy Family errands, etc.) must complete a 20-minute online defensive driving training prior to driving for school activities. This includes drivers of both school vehicles and private vehicles.

Be sure to use “Dubuque” in the pull-down menu on the main page and **select the location of your youngest child as the primary school** when registering your account.

At the end of the training, each participant will complete a driver questionnaire. This will include questions about your personal insurance coverage limits so you will want to have your insurance card available.
