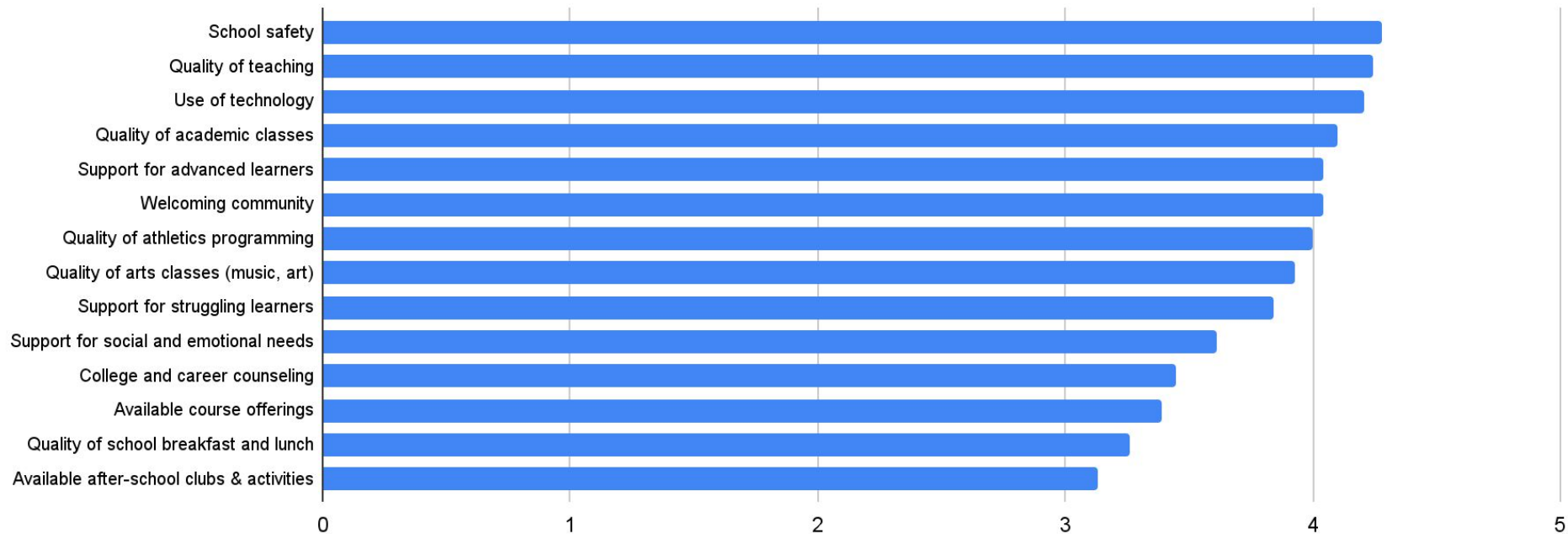

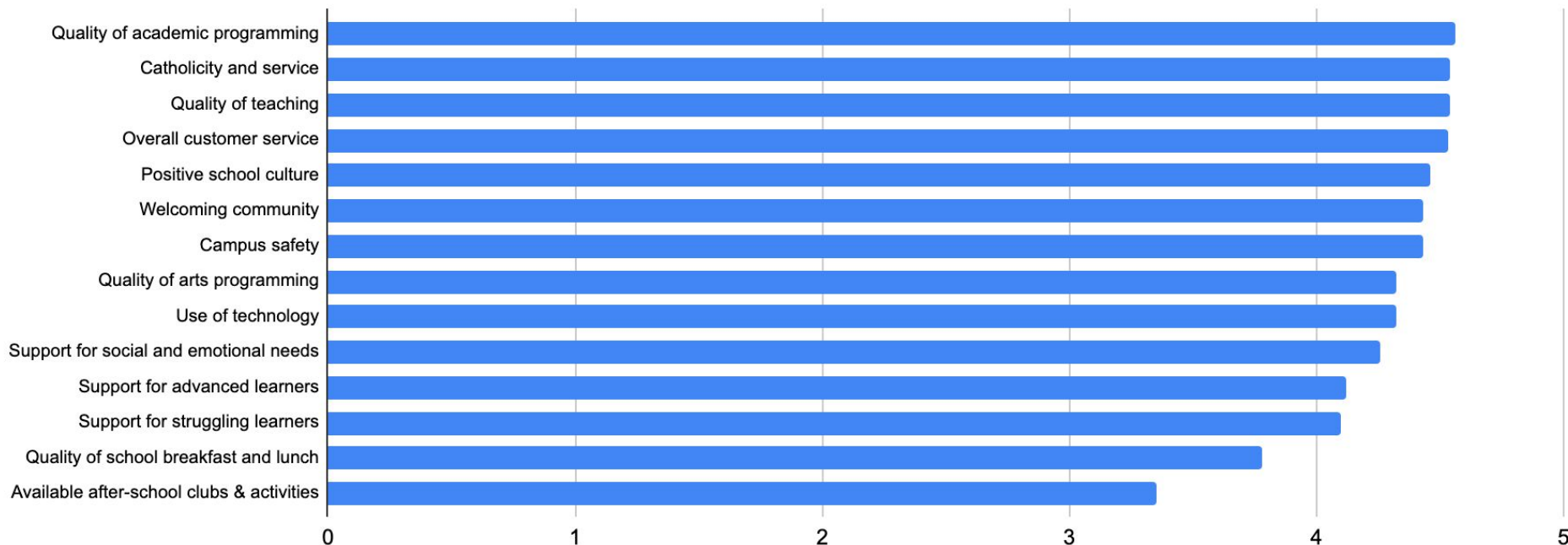

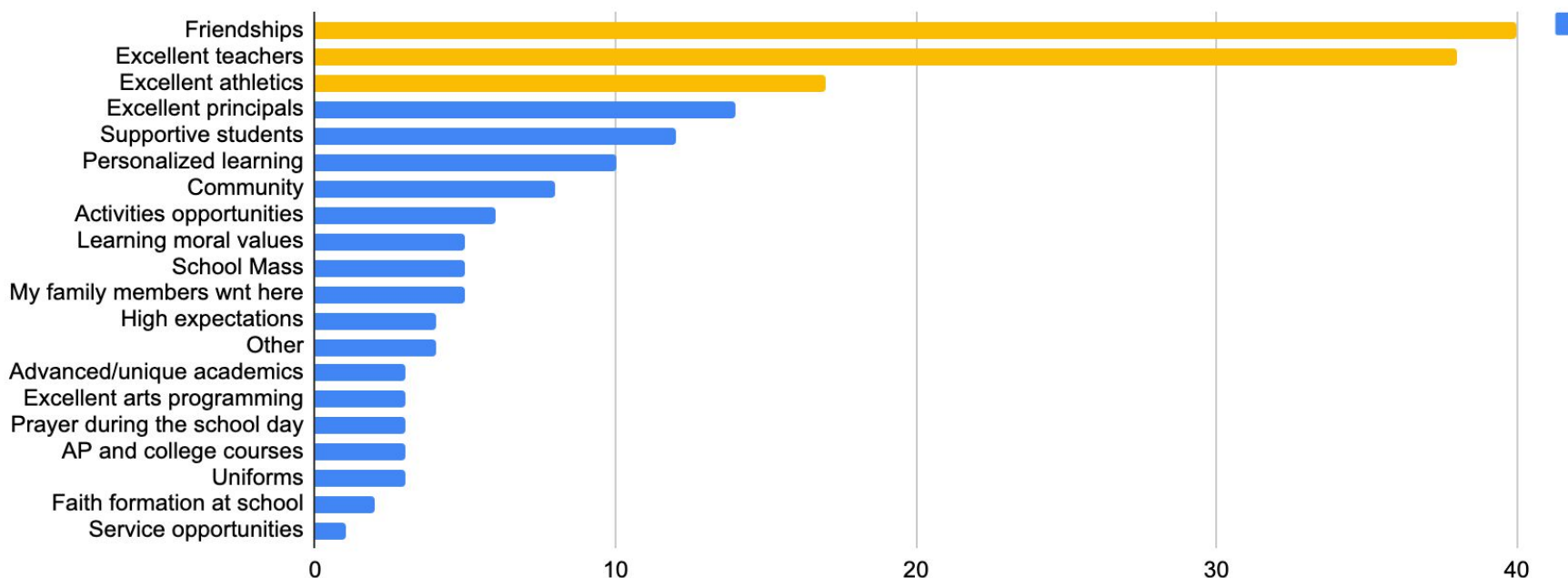

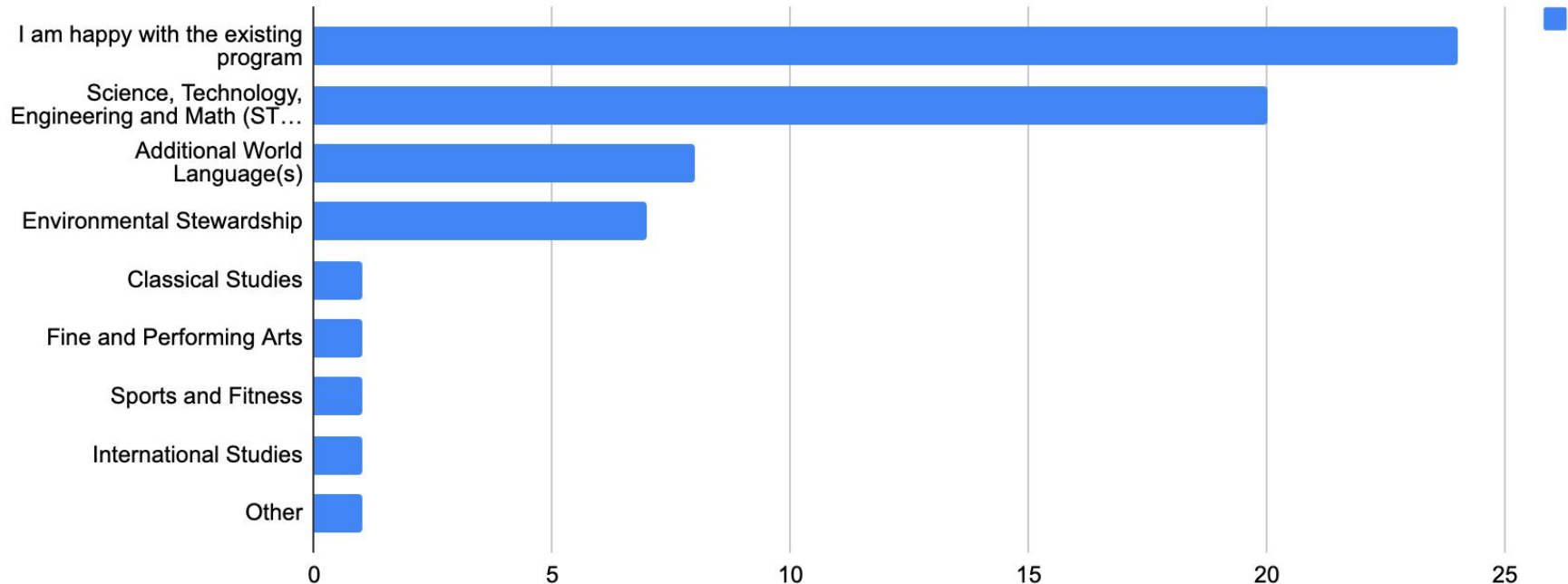

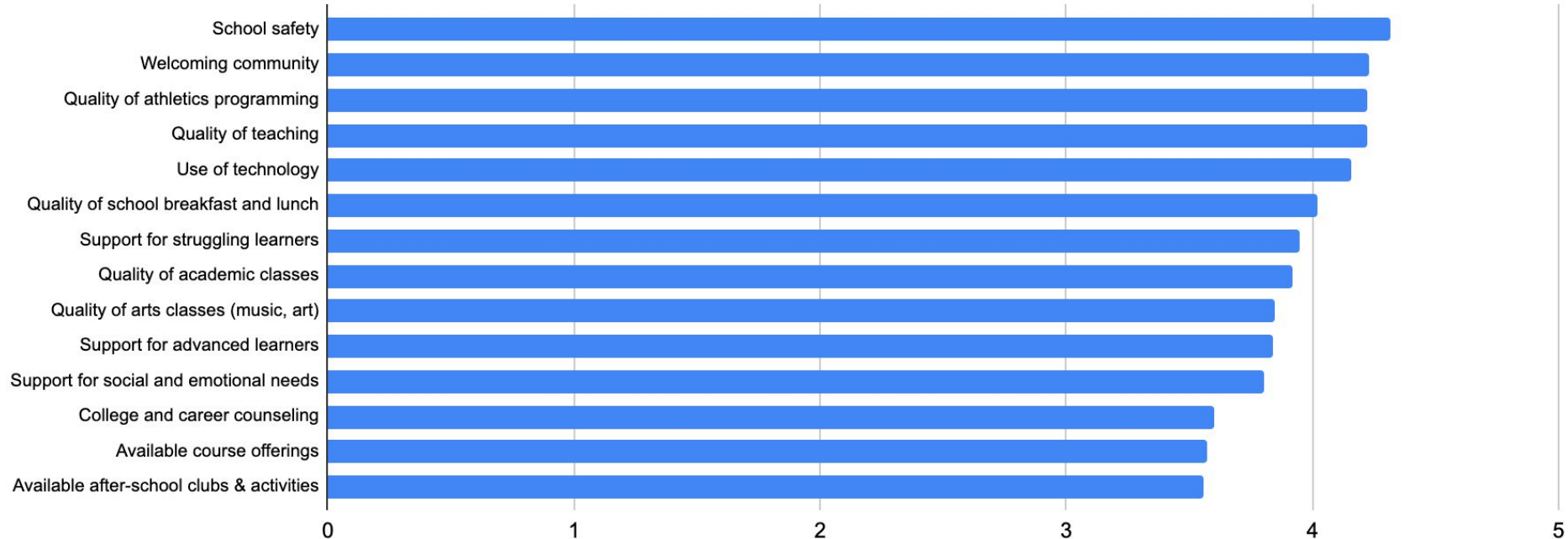

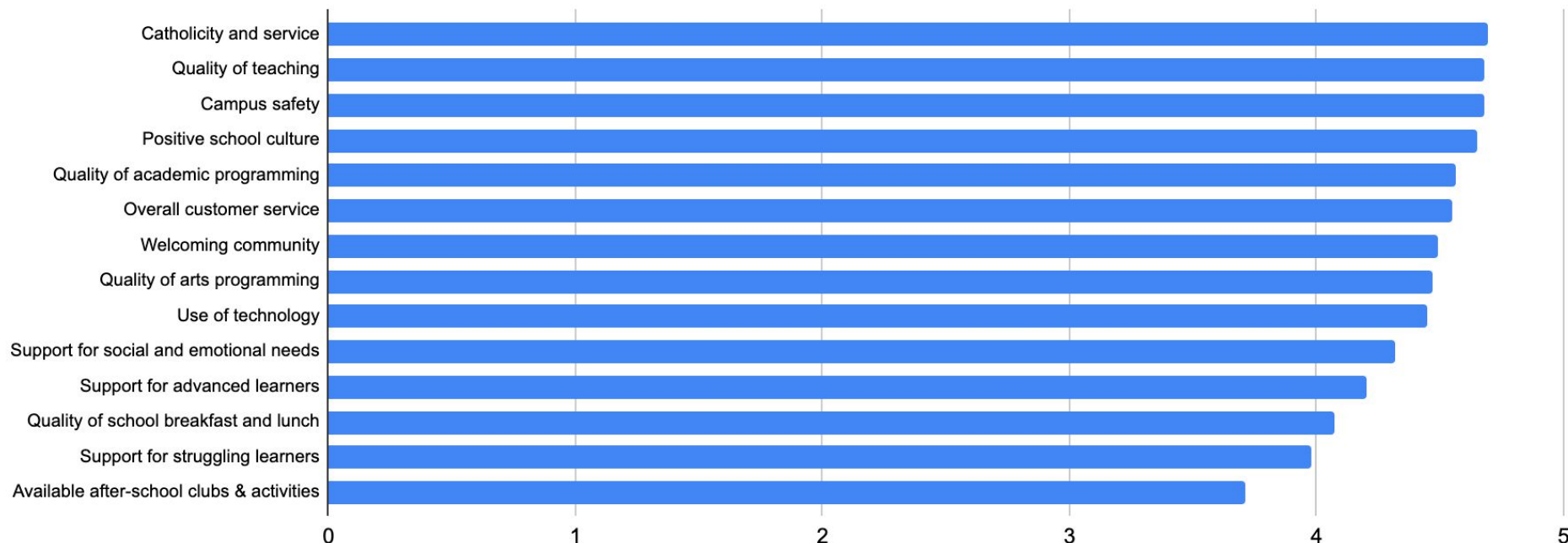

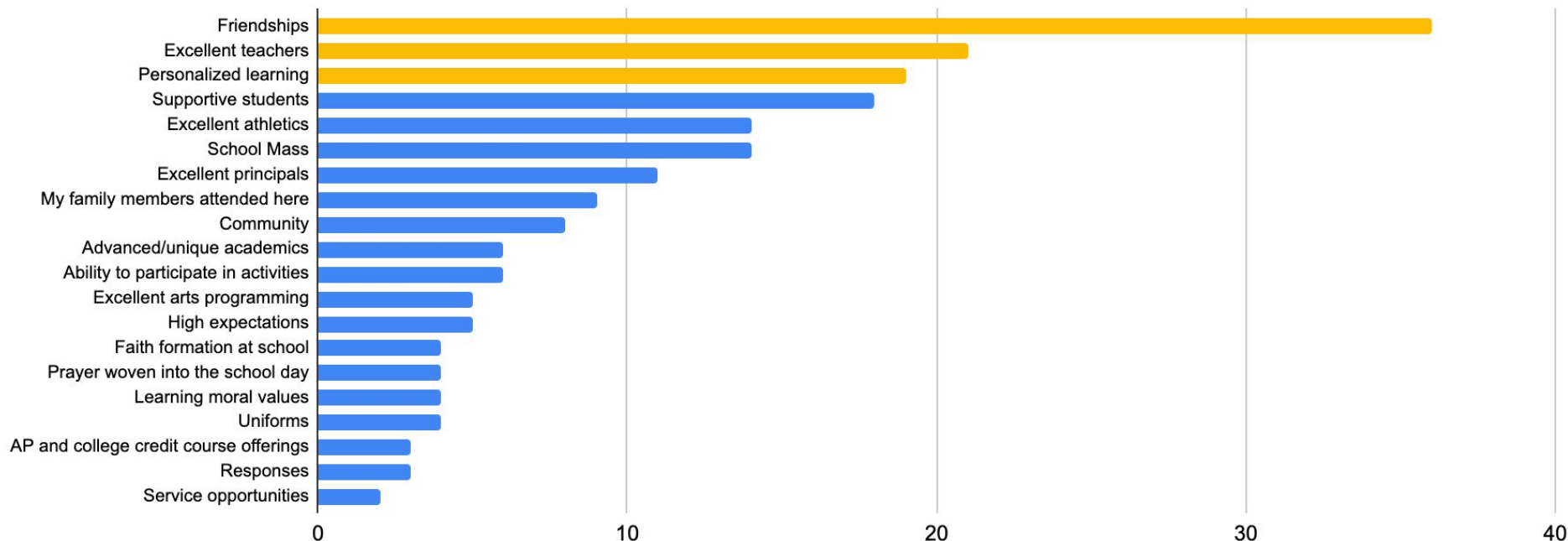

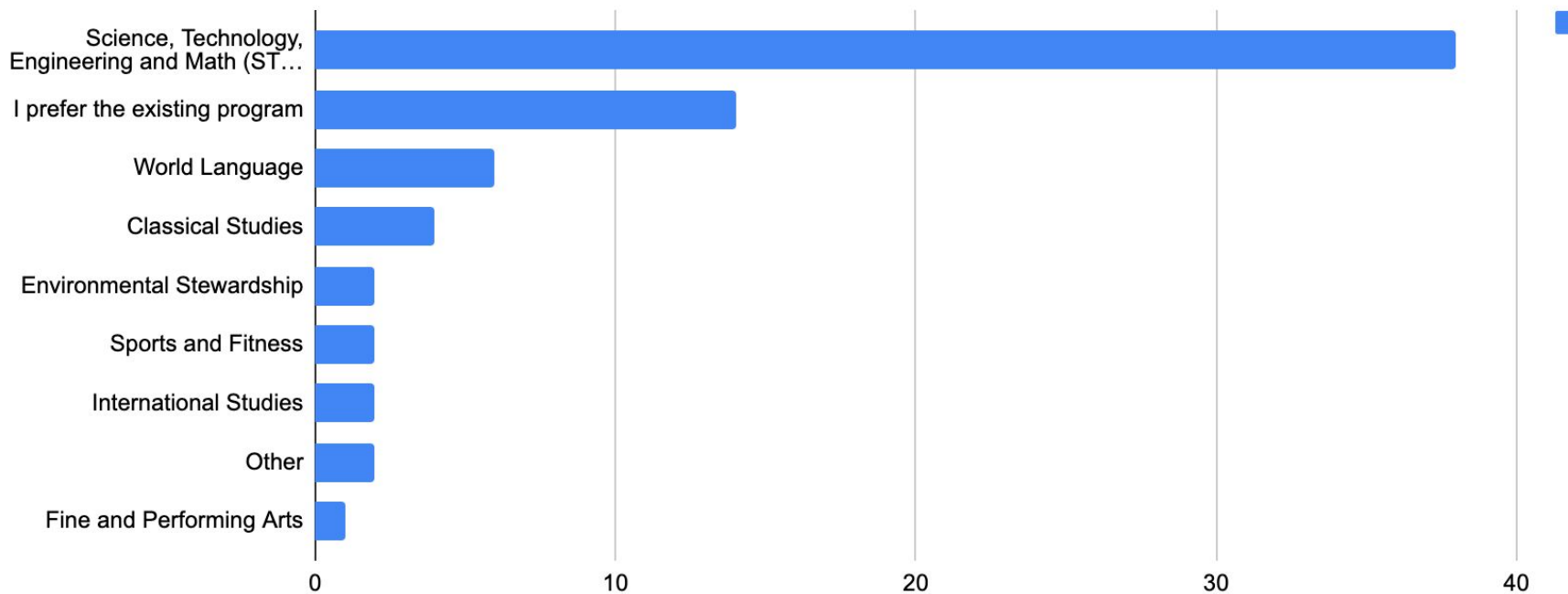

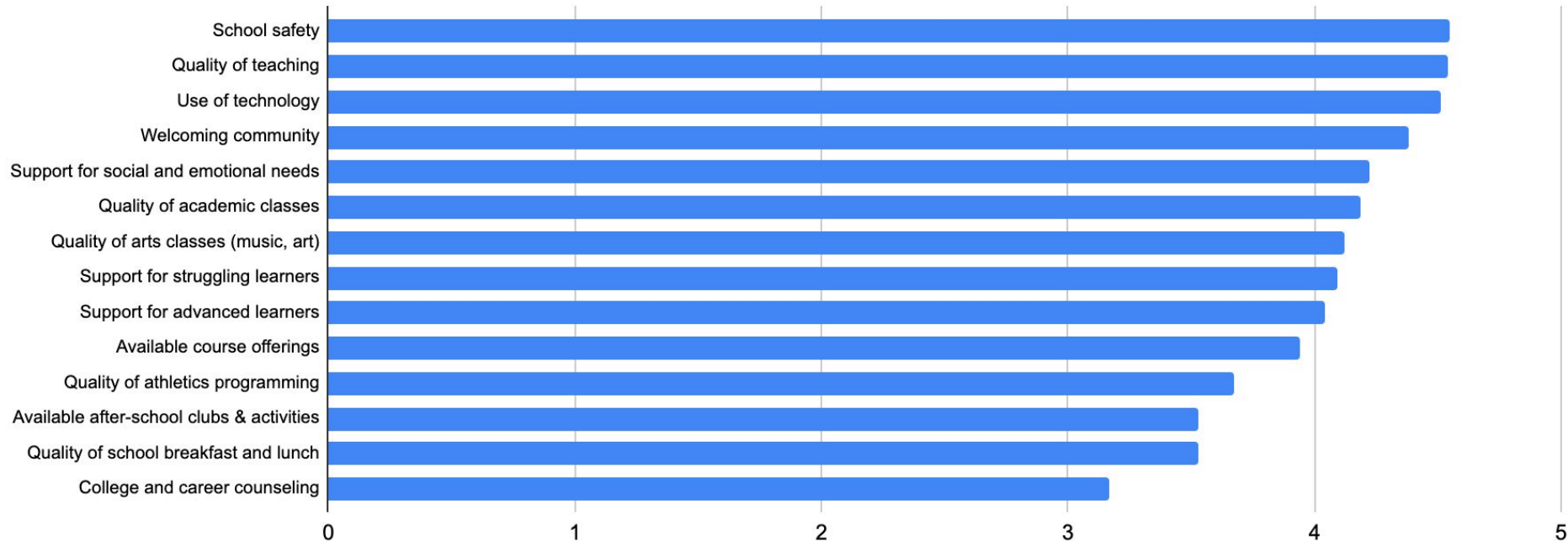

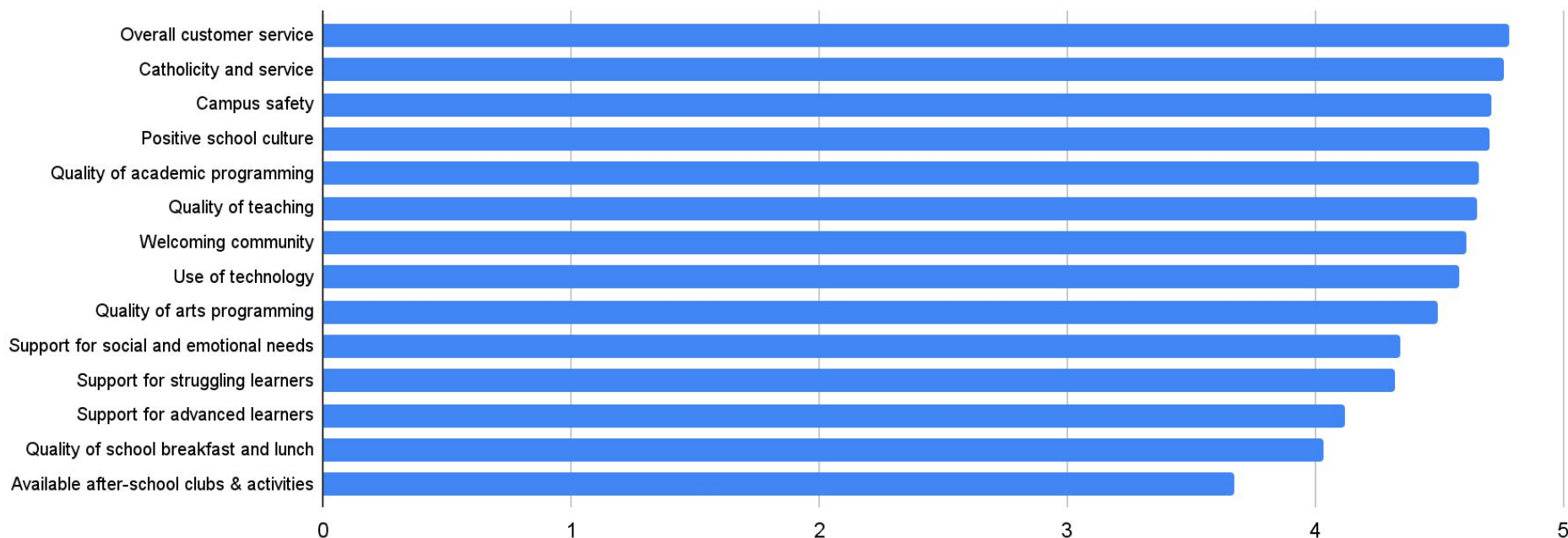

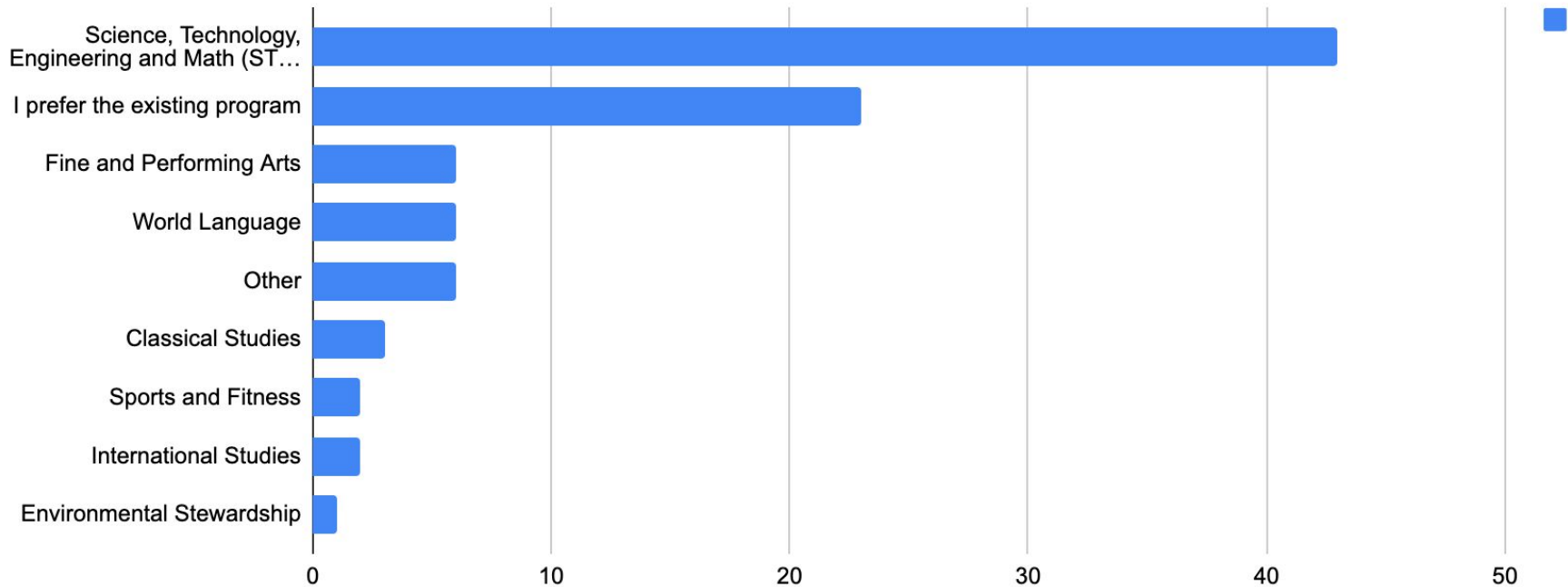

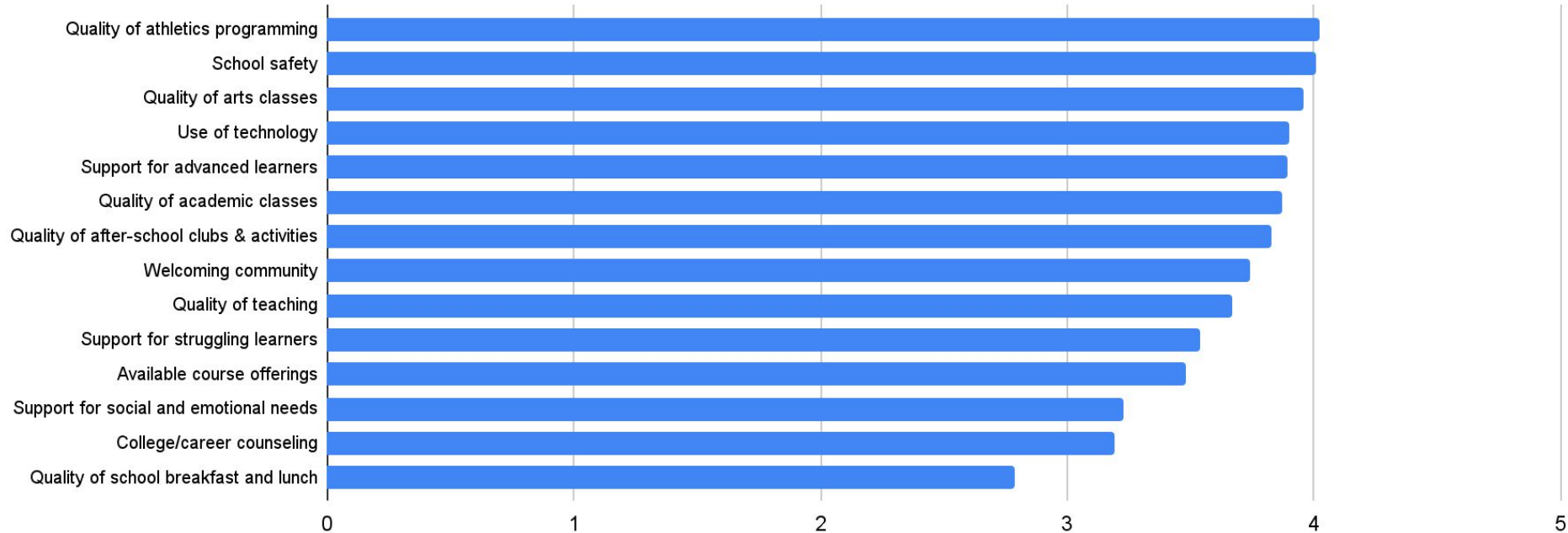

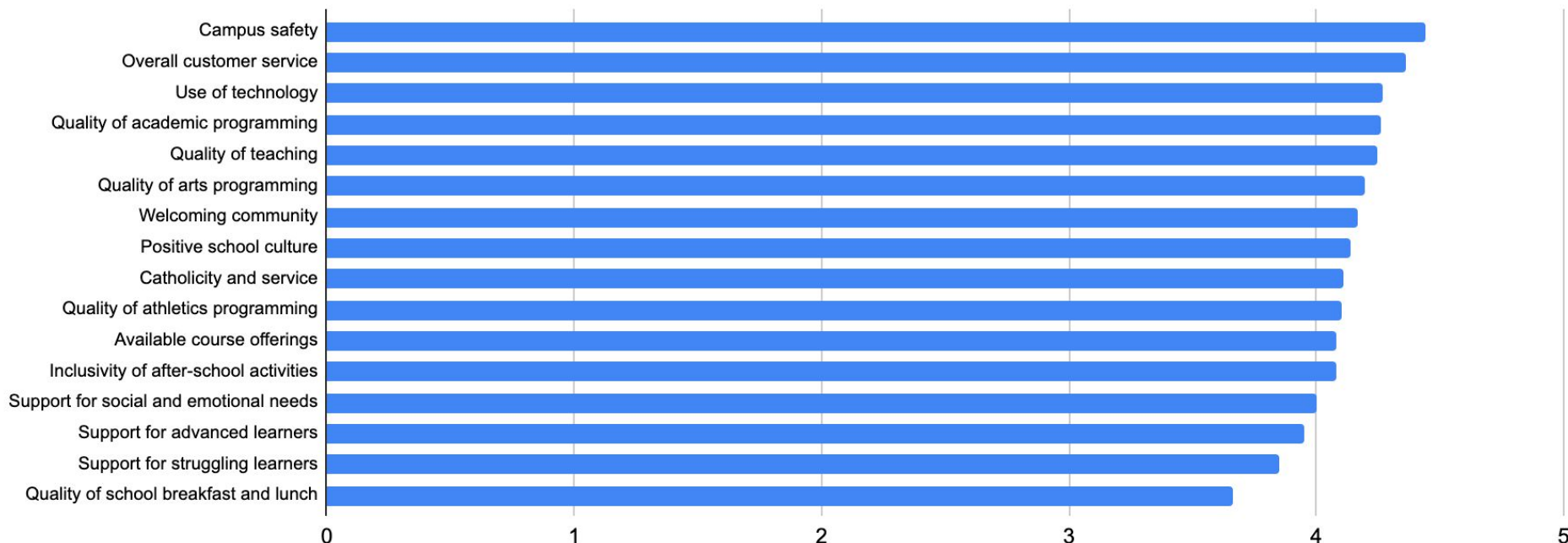

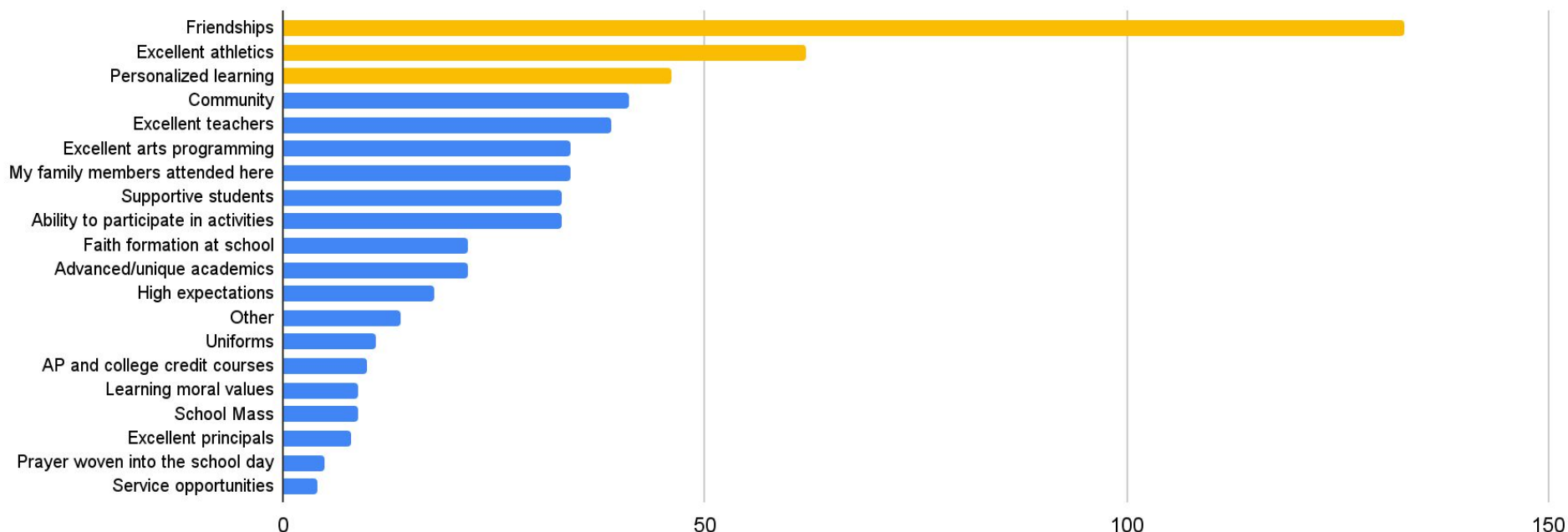

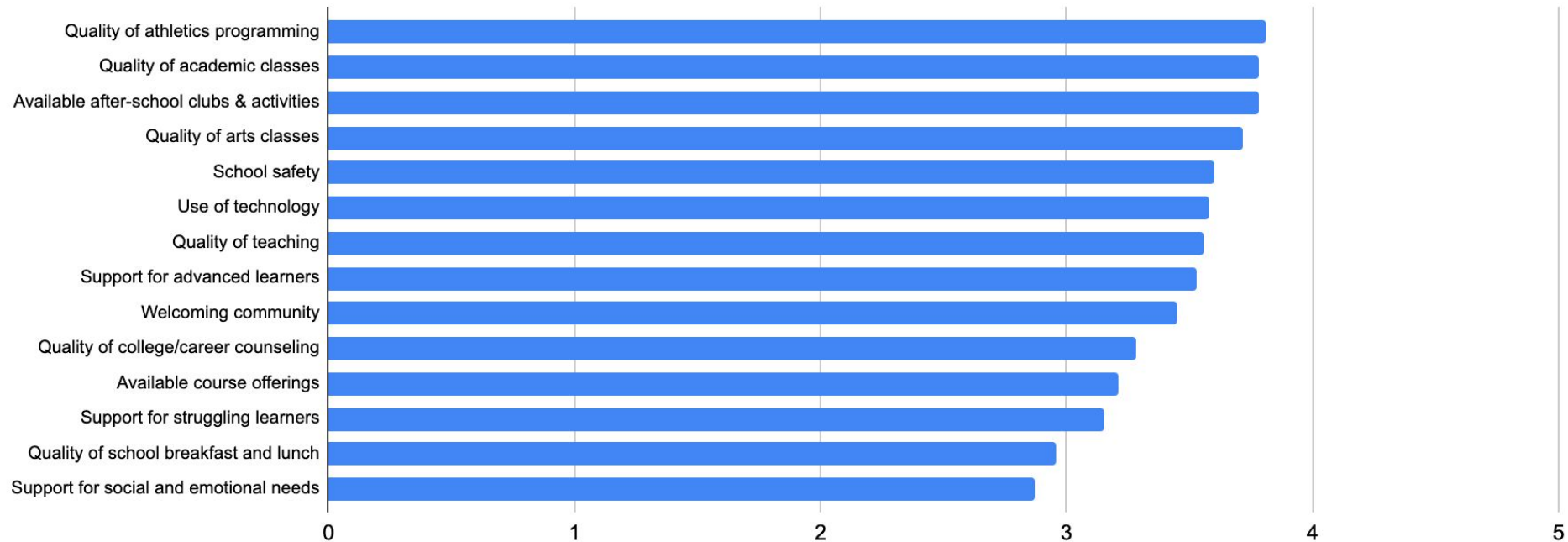

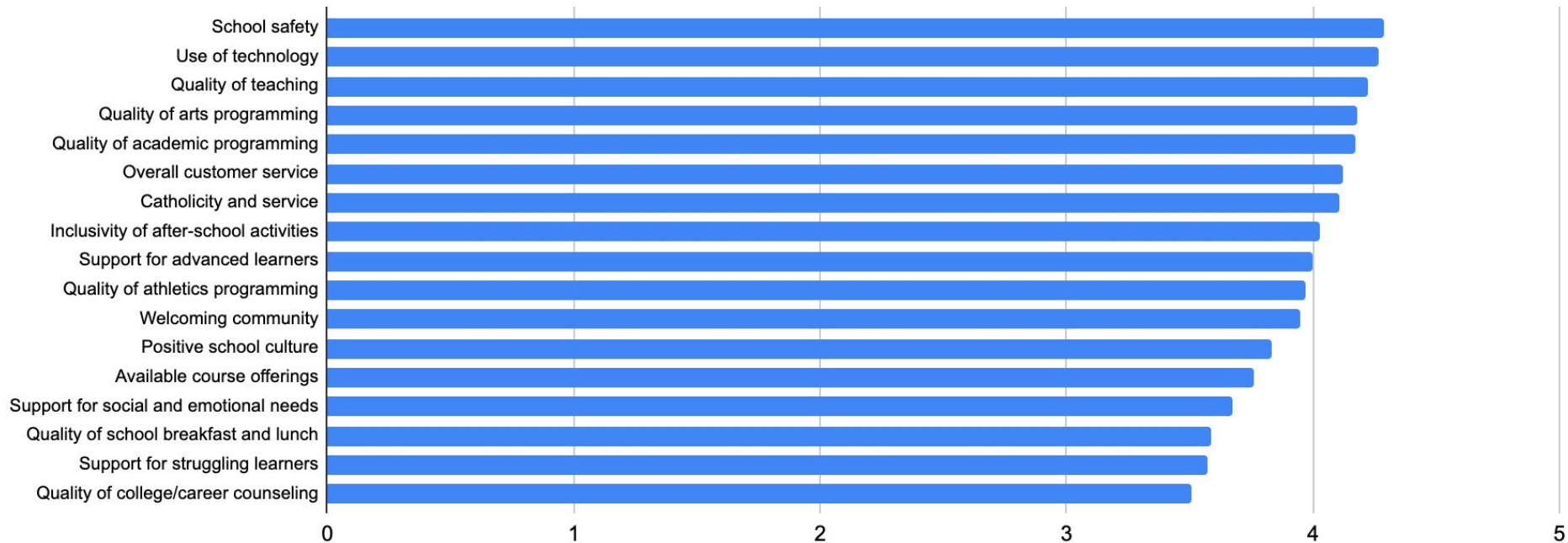

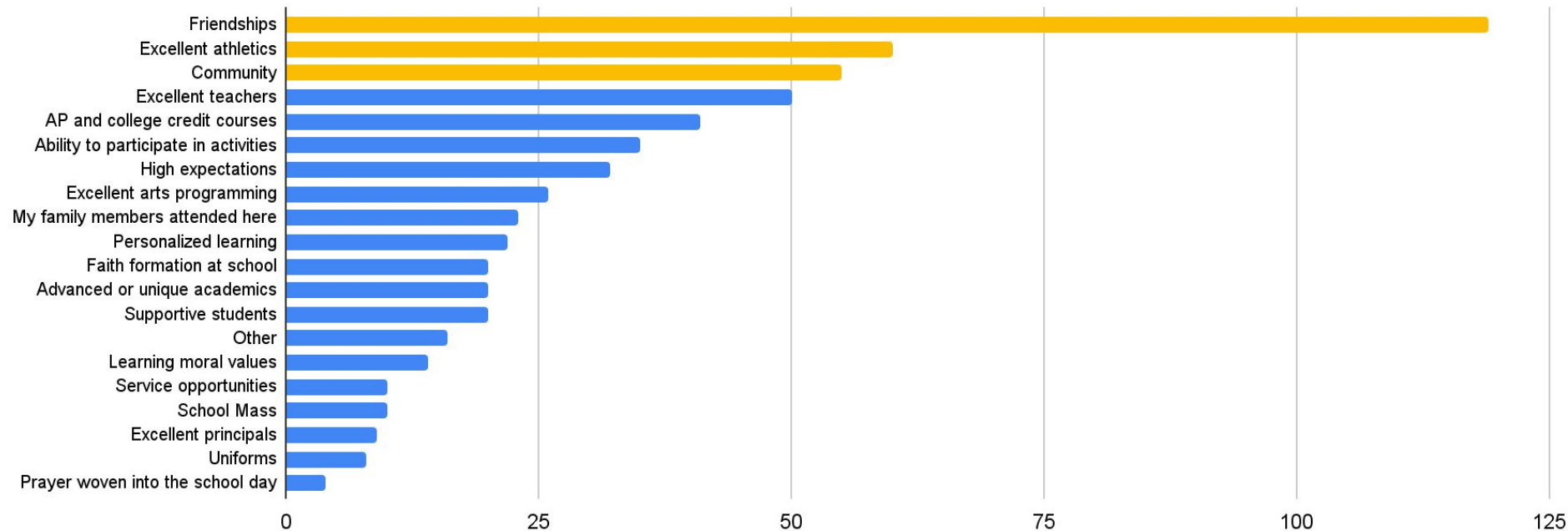

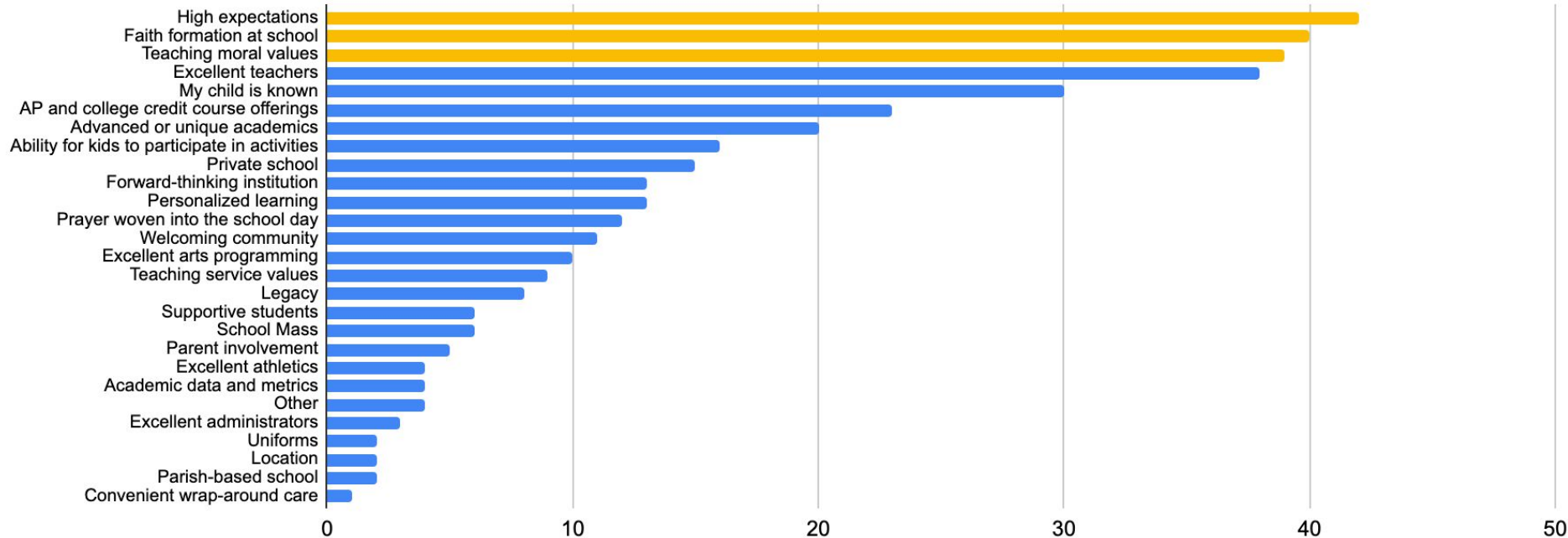

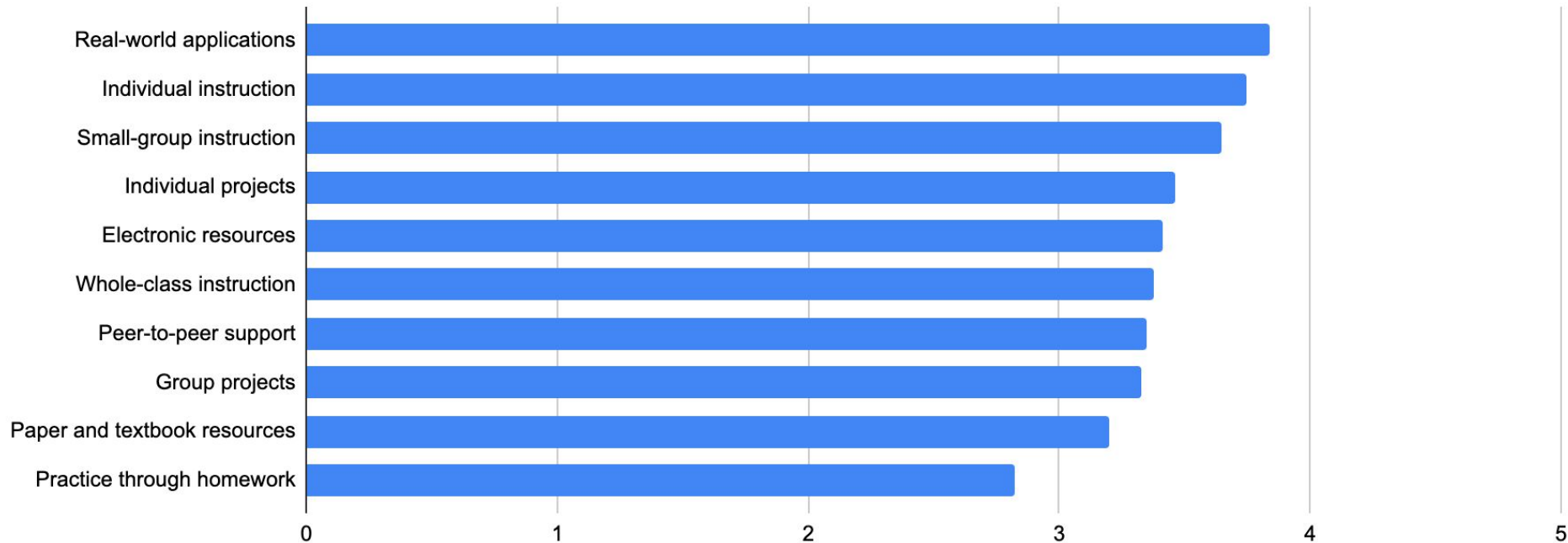

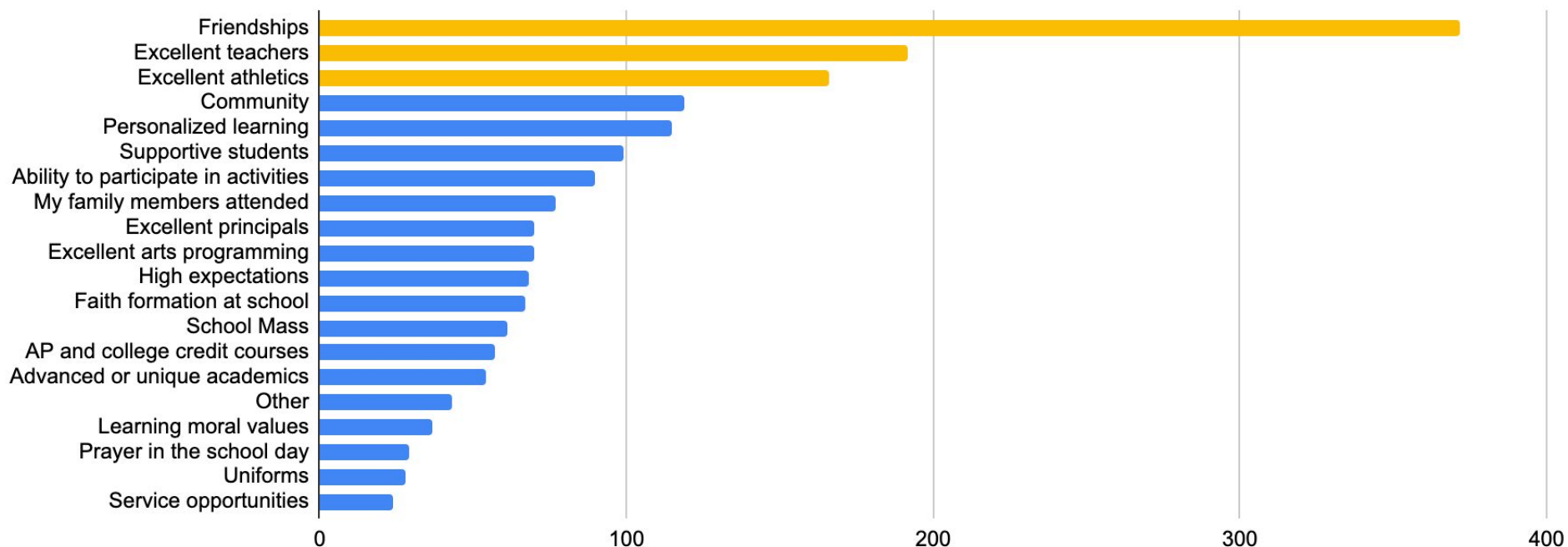

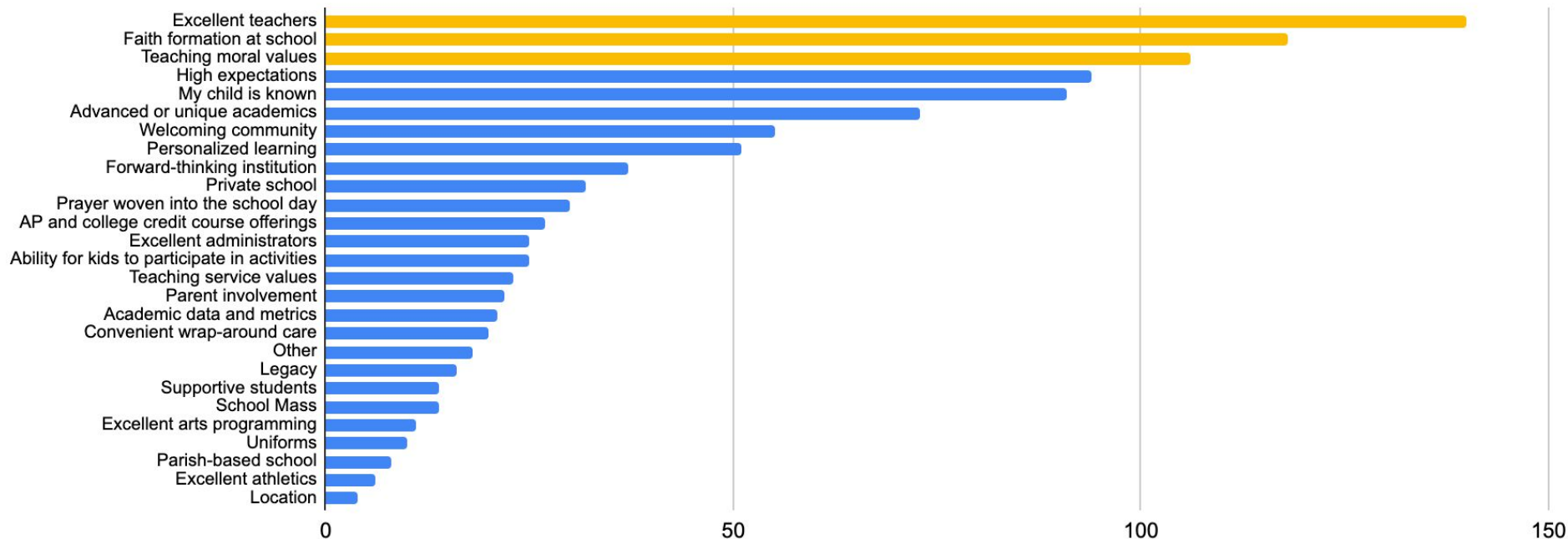

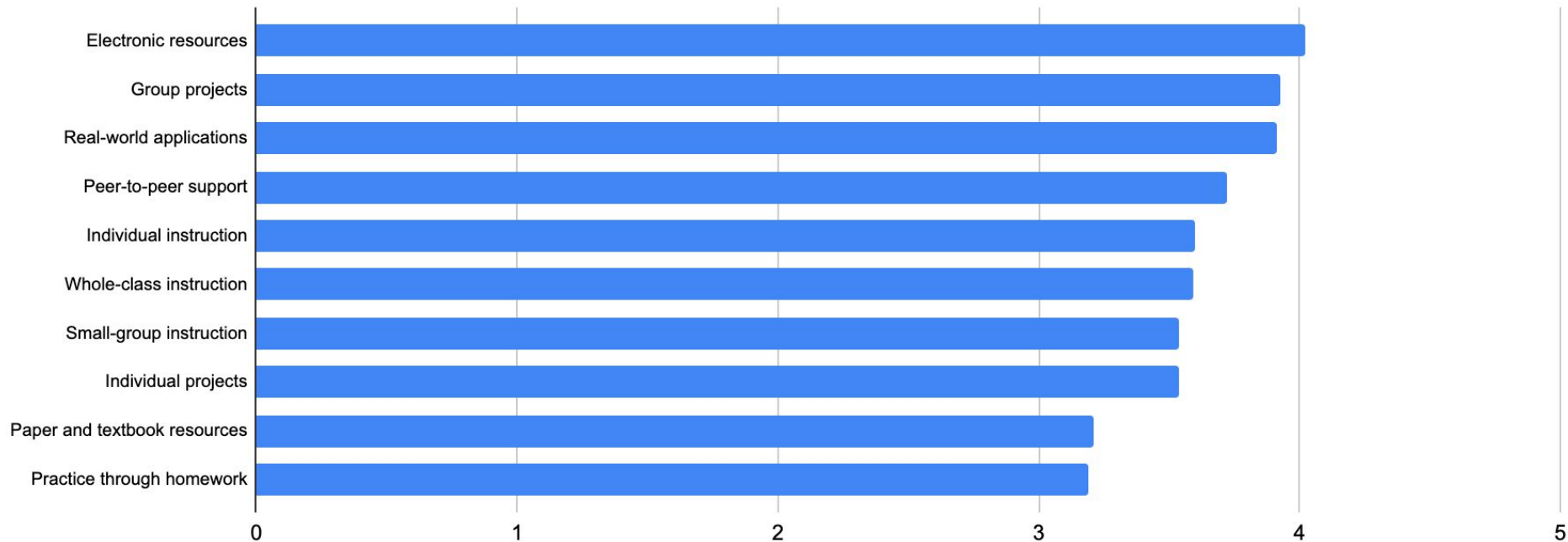

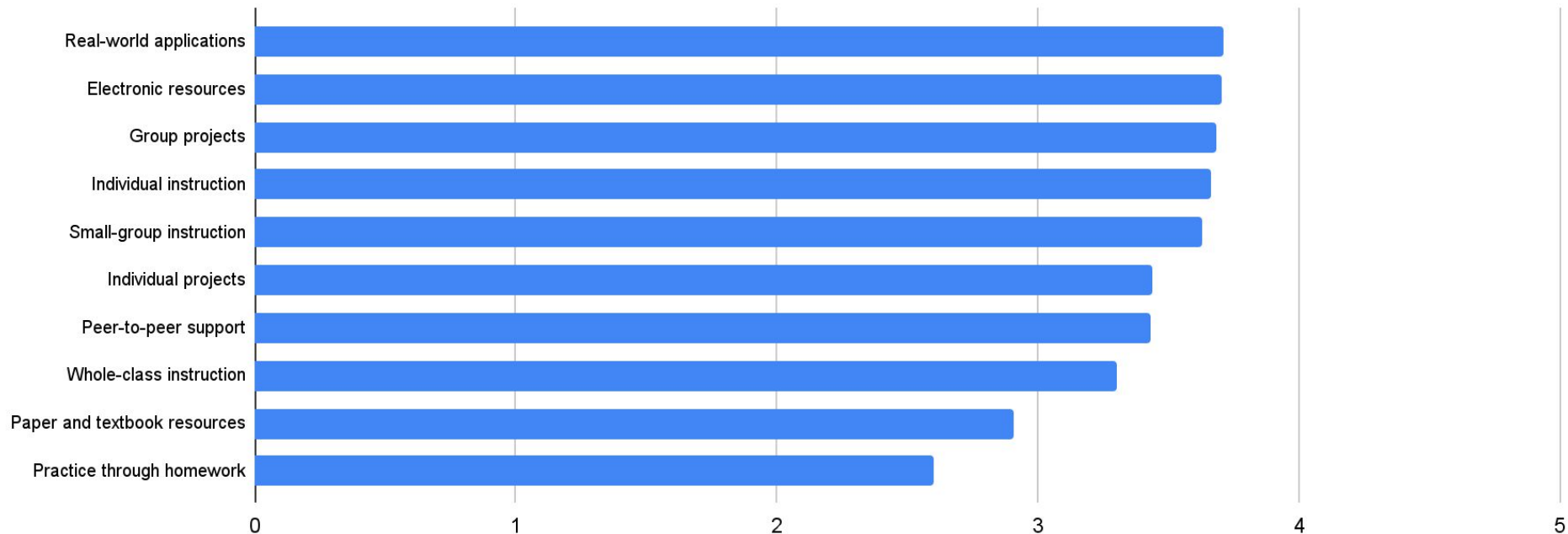

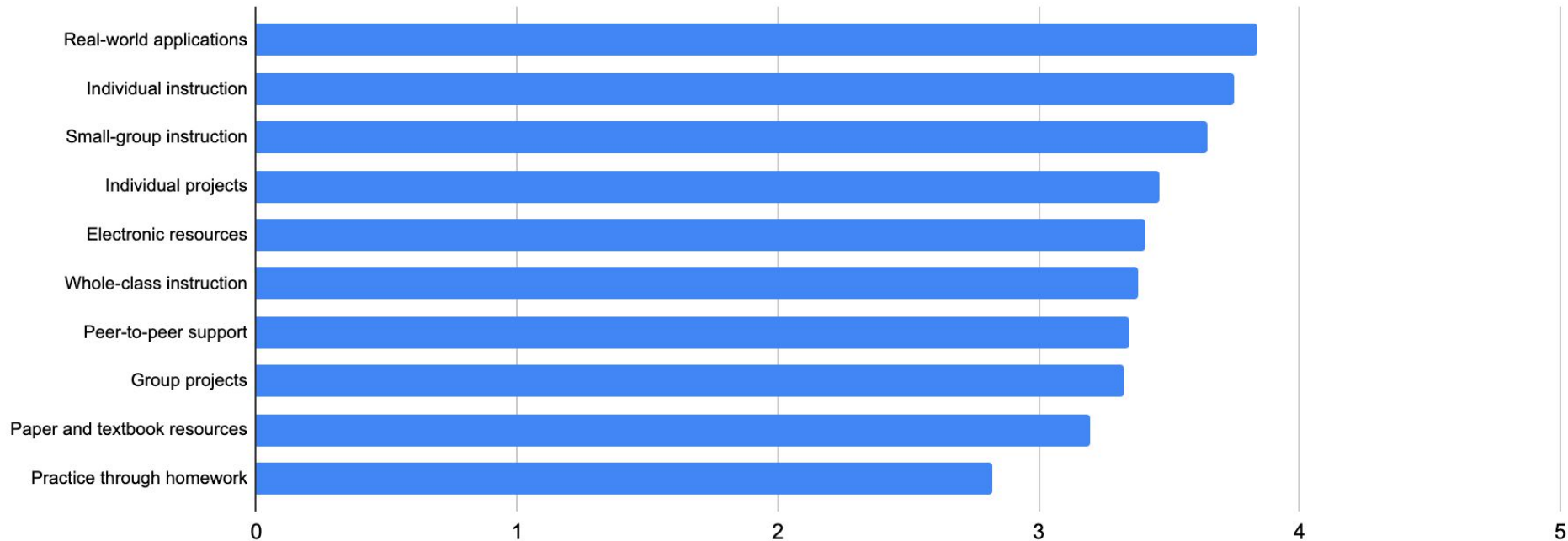

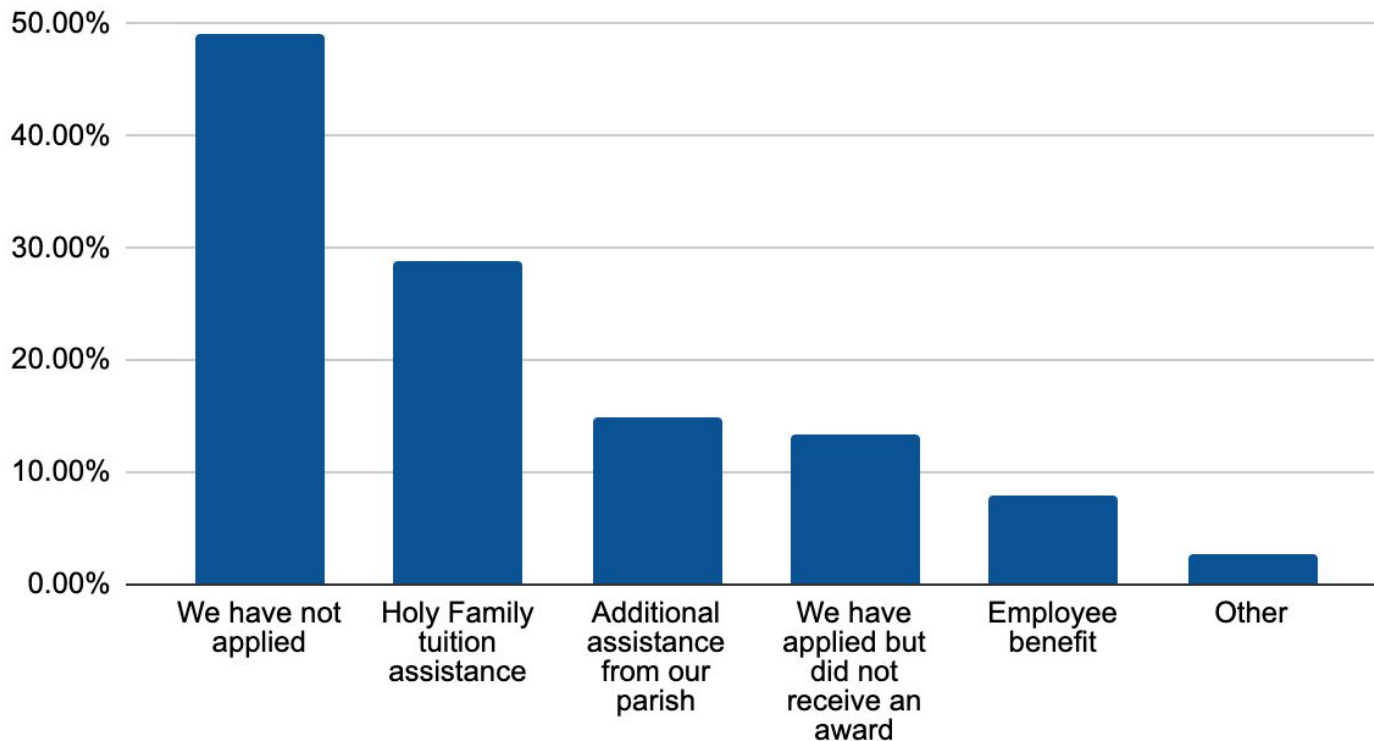

Financial Assistance Received



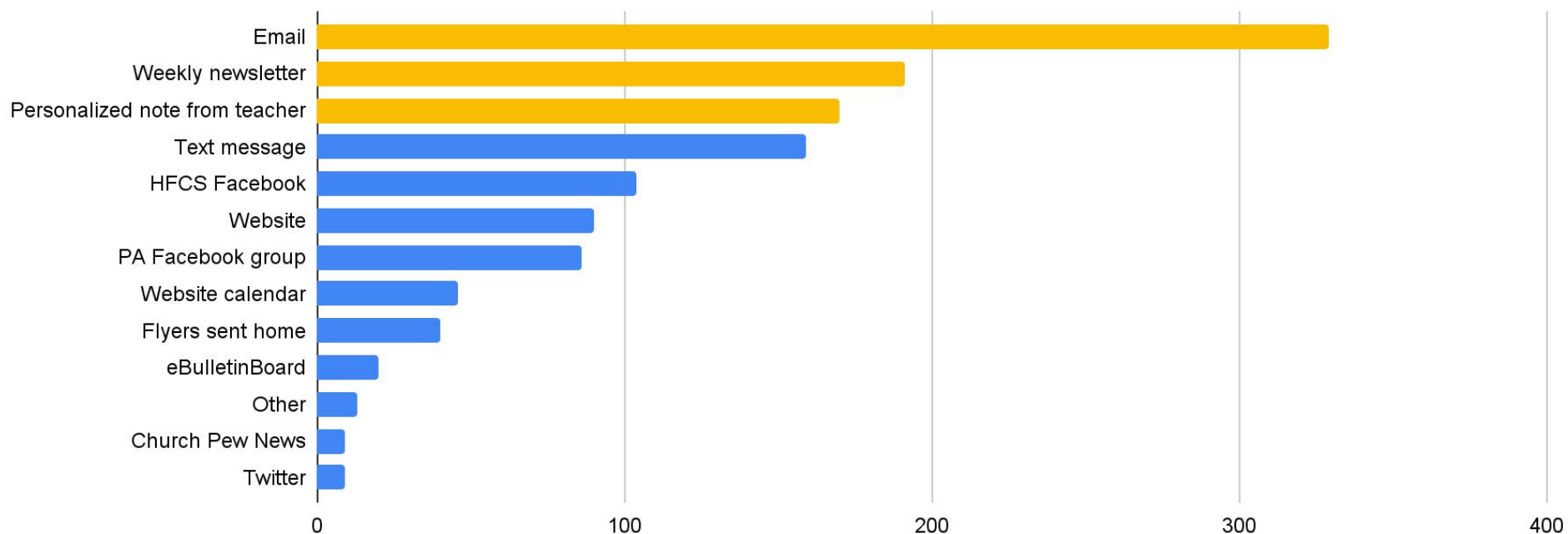
Ninety-six percent of respondents indicate they are familiar with the financial assistance opportunities available.

Preferred Sources of Information (ranked by number of selections)

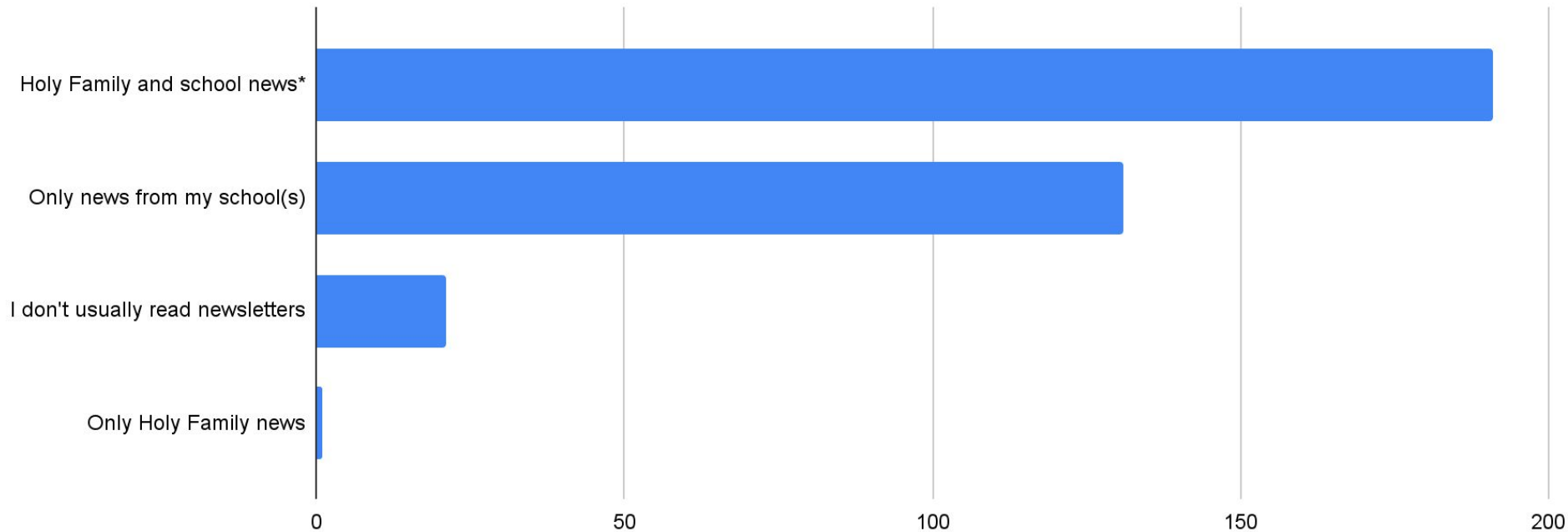
