Dubuque County Dairy Association Scholarship Rules and Regulations

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded at the Dubuque County Dairy Association Banquet on April 9th at the Dubuque County Fairgrounds Ballroom.

- Applicant must be considered or accepted as a full-time student at an accredited college.
- Applicant must contribute to Midwest Dairy checkoff as of January 1 of the current calendar year by one of the following:
 - Applicant, or applicant's parents/guardians/grandparents/sibling, must own a dairy farm residing in Dubuque County.
 - Applicant must be employed on a dairy farm residing in Dubuque County and recommended by the producer employer.
- Applicant or Applicant's parent/guardian must be members in good standing (\$5 dues paid)
 with the Dubuque County Dairy Association by the banquet.
- Complete and return the application form by April 9th, 2022.
