

Sons of the American Legion \$1,000 Scholarship

Eligibility and Required Materials

- Child/grandchild or legally adopted child or the child of a spouse by prior marriage or dependent child of a veteran of any branch of military service or a member of the SAL. The person must be a member of the American Legion Post 6 of Dubuque, or past member now deceased.
- This scholarship is intended to help pay tuition costs at an accredited college or university, community college, or technical school.
- High School seniors, students currently enrolled in a post-high school program, or a person entering their first year of post high school education are eligible to apply.
- High School senior must have a 2.50 grade point average, on a 4.00 scale. Post-high school students must have a 2.00 grade point average, on a 4.00 scale.
- High School senior must submit their acceptance letter to the college or university and post-high school students must submit their transcript from their post-high school with the application.
- Military service history of the parent/grandparent must be outlined.
- The recipient is asked to volunteer to prepare for and/or serve one of the two breakfasts the Sons of the American Legion hold each year.
- The application takes the form of an essay, up to 1,000 words, of the applicants needs, work history, community involvement, and thoughts on the military.
- Please provide name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address.
- A person may receive this scholarship only once.
