How to participate

- Participants are required to attend the club meetings every two weeks starting 6 pm Monday, May 19 at the Dubuque Arboretum and Botanical Gardens. Meetings will occur 6 pm Mondays at the Dubuque Arboretum.
- Each participant must have access to their own garden space at home to plant the supplied garden plants (a 125 square foot space is ideal).
- Participants must sign up as a Dubuque County 4-H member.
- Club is limited to 20 participants in grades 4 – 12.
